On Friday, 9th May 2014, the Technical Conference on *"Greece, a Sea and Land Transportation Hub through the Centuries"* in Divani Acropolis Hotel was held with great success where the number of participants exceeded 150. The conference was

attended by representatives of ICE from 18 countries and numerous representatives from the technical profession of Greece, including representatives of the Ministry of Infrastructure, Transport and Networks, from companies like: GEFYRA S.A., AEGEAN MOTORWAY S.A., OLYMPIA CONSTRUCTION Joint Venture, NEW ODOS S.A., URS, OMEK etc., as well as Professors of Greek Universities and members of the Greek LA.

The speakers, Mr Antonis Antoniadis, Chief Operations Officer at VIANOX SVOLOS SA, Dr. George Malindretos, Assistant Professor of Economics and Ecology at HAROKOPIO UNIVERCITY and Dr. Vedicos Nikolaos, Assistant Professor at the Laboratory for Maritime Transport at NATIONAL TECHNICAL UNIVERCITY of Athens, developed the topic of Logistics in Greece from ancient times till today and the importance of ports for international transportation. Mrs. Isaia-Keramida, Consultant to the General Director of **ERGOSE** referred to the development of railways in Greece but also their connection with the country's ports.

Mr. Mandalozis, Chairman of the Committee for the Environment of the INTERNATIONAL ROAD FEDERATION (IRF) and Director of Strategic and Organization at ATTIKES DIADROMES S.A., presented the topic of planning and strategic planning of international highways based on sustainable and environmental development. Dr.. Papanikolas, Vice President and Managing Director at GEFYRA S.A., focused on the Rio-Atirrio bridge, the challenges of such a large project both during construction and operation and maintenance. Mr. Deputy Papakrivopoulos. Director of the MALIAKOS - KLEIDI Construction Joint Venture presented the highway project "Maliakos - Kleidi", analyzing the technical particularities of the project. Dr. loannis Anestis, Director of Design and Support in NEA ODOS SA, discussed the plans of the European Union for the future of transportation infrastructure along with some new techniques for reconstruction and construction of Professor of the NATIONAL pavements. **TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY of Athens, Dr. Sergios** Lambropoulos talked about the need of

Monday 12th of May was the last day of the European Local Association Conference, which was the day of the site visits. Two of the most interesting and diverse sites of Athens were visited!

On an early start all participants walk up from the hotel to the Acropolis Hill to visit the most important Engineering Wonder, **the Parthenon on the Hill of Acropolis**. The tour guide took everyone on a very interesting journey back to Ancient Athens, covering the history of the Parthenon Temple, the ways of its construction and its purpose. During the visit everyone had the opportunity to also see the refurbishment works which were currently on going which are due to be finalized in a few months.

The second site visit was at a more modern and the largest construction site currently on going in Greece, the Stavros Niarchos Foundation Cultural Centre. The site consists of the construction and the outfitting of the facilities of the National Opera House, the National Library and of the 170000m2 Park. Uppon arrival at the site's Visitors' Center the Project's Technical Director and the Foundation's Board Member Mr Maravelias gave a very interesting presentation on the start, progress and vision of the Project. Participants had the chance to ask several questions on the technical and the social and cultural aspects of the Project. From the balcony of the visitors' center everyone witnessed the impressive construction works which were in full speed at the time of the visit. At that point the last group photo was taken.
