Entering the ICE North West Civil Engineering Awards 2023 in five easy steps

1. Go to our dedicated ICE North West Awards page

[The web page](#) is the place to go for all award related information.

2. Let us know you're interested

Complete an [Expression of Interest](#) form by Thursday 17 November 2022, to help with our planning.

3. Gather your information

A list of all the required information is included at the start of the online entry form. Make sure you read it and get everything ready including contact details, written information, videos, images, drawings and membership numbers. It's important you get permission from the main parties involved before starting your entry.

4. Pay for your entry, if applicable

All Project and **Constructability** entries cost £200 + VAT to enter - [pay now](#)

5. Submit your entry online by Thursday, 8 December 2022

- Large, Medium and Small Projects
- Constructability
- The Mercer Innovation Award - supported by Tensar International, included within all project and constructability entries
- Team
- Diversity
- Rising Star Award

Once you've completed your entry and your files have been successfully loaded, you'll get a confirmation of receipt. We will be checking all submissions and will get in touch if anything else is required.

Projects *

- Showcasing excellence across the ICE North West Region
- Large Project (over £15 million); Medium project (£5 to £15 million); Small project (up to £5 million)

Constructability *

- Showing how a collaborative approach can create industry-leading excellence in the design for the safe construction of a scheme

Mercer Innovation Award

- Complete the Innovation section, part of the **project/constructability application**, to be included in the judging for the Mercer Innovation Award, supported by Tensar International, driving a focus on innovative practice at the forefront of the region's civil engineering profession

Team

- Awarded to the most dynamic, diverse and collaborative team

Diversity

- Highlighting diversity best practice

Rising Star

- For an engineer at the earlier stages of their career, demonstrating their positive impact

Note, sustainability is integral to ALL projects so forms part of each project entry.

Rules of entry

1. All award entries must clearly be concerned with civil engineering activity in the ICE North West region: Cheshire, Cumbria, the Isle of Man, Lancashire, Greater Manchester and Merseyside.
2. The judges can only act on the information provided in the submission and the judges' decision is final.
3. ICE North West reserves the right to edit any copy submitted due to editorial constraints in our publications/news releases and to use images submitted in any future publications, news items and promotional materials. This covers subsequent publicity and promotion of the awards by ICE North West for presentation and media purposes.
4. Agreement to submit an entry must be obtained from all relevant parties; these parties must be listed within the entry.
5. All submitted entries will be considered and the winning entries announced at the awards ceremony.
6. Category winners may be contacted to share their learning via an ICE lecture, blog, online event as appropriate.

Award entry criteria

Entry Fee £200+VAT, is applicable to all Project and Constructability entries.

Project Costs Projects of all sizes can enter the Projects category within the following budget categories - Large Project (over £15 million); Medium Project (between £5 and £15 million); Small Project (under £5 million). There are no budget restrictions for Constructability, Diversity entries or people-based awards.

Location All Project and Constructability entries must concern completed work in the ICE North West region; Team/Diversity nominees must work on projects located within the ICE North West region and include ICE members.
Rising Star nominees must be members working within the ICE North West boundaries.

Timing All Project and Constructability entries must relate to activity completed two calendar years from the entry date.
Diversity practices must be currently in use.
The Team and Rising Star awards will be made primarily for activities within the previous calendar year, although activity over a longer period will also be considered.

Nominees Team nominations must come from an ICE member but not all members of the team are required to be ICE members.
Rising Star nominees must be ICE members.
